WDPORT OF GHENT:

FIRST DEVELOPMENT OF 20,000 M² FOR DISTRILOG GROUP AT KLUIZENDOK IN THE PORT OF GHENT

Two years after WDP announced the launch of its multimodal WDPort of Ghent project, construction can now begin on a new tailor-made development of over 20,000 m² at the Kluizendok for the Distrilog Group. This port project will be completed in close collaboration with the Ghent Port Company.


WDP is kicking off its first project in the Port of Ghent

After the announcement¹ of this multimodal site – unique in Flanders – WDP and its partner, the Ghent Port Company, are pleased to announce the first project: the kick-off of the development on a new 20,000 m²-warehouse for the Distrilog Group, partner of WDP at various sites in its real estate portfolio. The project is slated for completion in the second quarter of 2016. The investment by WDP is estimated at some 10 million euros.



WDPort of Ghent is a true port project that fits into the predetermined strategy to support further expansion of the Port of Ghent and the Kluizendok. WDP has long recognized the economic and ecological importance of multimodal sites. This first project is crucial to further expansion of the WDPort of Ghent, in light of the increased importance of this site in recent months. WDP is optimistic: the kick-off of this first project will only further pique interest in this site.

The highly constructive partnership with the Ghent Port Company, the Municipality of Evergem and the City of Ghent attests to the added value of partners with shared interests in both the private and public sectors and has made a more concrete contribution to effective preparation of the construction works. Construction has been underway since last week.



The Port of Ghent is banking on logistics activity

The Ghent Port Company is very pleased with the kick-off of this development on the WDPort of Ghent by WDP. After all, the Port Company is seeking to attract several European (logistics) distribution centres. This investment will allow the Port of Ghent to reinforce its position in the logistics activities sector with added value.

With this site on the Kluizendok, WDP benefits from the unique features of the Port of Ghent as a multimodal port. Direct access to water heading out to sea and inland waterways, roadways (the E17 and E40) and railways offer efficient transport to all corners of Europe.

The WDPort of Ghent is located at the Kluizendok, next to the *Ovaal van Wippelgem* interchange on R4-West motorway. It is also a major investment in the territory of the Municipality of Evergem, which the port area partially spans.

Distrilog Group believes in the power of multimodality for logistics

In recent years, as a renowned logistics player, the Distrilog Group already expanded its impressive infrastructure by 315,000 m², for example with sites in Willebroek, Vilvoorde and Olen. Thanks to the strategic location, multimodal connection and the link to industry from East and West Flanders, this project is an ideal expansion of the current capacity of this logistics service provider. This site will be fitted with a hazardous goods zone and will also be the number-4 site in the group with a multimodal connection. To take full advantage of this opportunity, it will immediately serve as a *gateway* to the Distrilog Group's sustainable distribution network in the Benelux region. Initially, this new site will employ 35 people, with future growth potential for 50 jobs.

Bryan Beutels, Sales Director of the Distrilog Group: "The WDPort of Ghent is a key step in our growth strategy. We see this first 20,000 m^2 as a stepping stone to expansion of our expertise to a broader geographical market. And an additional opportunity to further optimise the flow of goods for our clients."
